ORDER

With a view to incentivise the farmers to take to dairying activities for self-employment and thereby to contribute to the economic development of the State, and in order to enhance milk procurement price payable to the producer-farmer, administrative approval is hereby accorded towards increasing the minimum procurement price of raw milk to Rs. 34 per Kg. (standard milk) in which the Banglar Dairy will pay Rs. 27 per Kg. and the Government will pay Rs. 7 per kg. as subsidy, subject to a maximum daily average procurement of 2,50,000 Kg. of raw milk by Banglar Dairy.

2. This order is issued with the concurrence of Finance Department vide their U.O. Nos. Group A-I/2021-2022/0102 Dt. 16.03.2022 & No. 6361, Gr. N Dt. 28.02.2022.
3. The order will take immediate effect.
